- 3. Candidate must be pursuing a two-year associate's degree or four-year bachelor's degree at a college in Beaufort County.**
- 4. The recipient must be available to attend the AAUW Beaufort Branch meeting in downtown Beaufort on May 25, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. to receive the award.**
- 5. Application is due by 4:00 p.m. Monday, April 26, 2010.**
- 6. Application must be complete, including the 300-word essay and two letters of recommendation.**
- 7. Candidate must submit a transcript showing current GPA.**
- 8. The award check will be payable to the recipient, not the school she is attending.**
- 9. The decision of the selection committee is final.**
- 10. The amount of the award will be determined by available funds.**
